Pecus Sheep & Goat 15 is a versatile, balanced diet formulated to be fed as creep feed, a complete diet under different conditions and a production supplement. Pecus Sheep & Goat 15 contains Lucerne and maize and a balance of protein sources to guarantee a minimum protein level of 15%.

- Molasses based to ensure palatability
- Ideal to be fed as is because it is balanced.
- Pelleted form to curb waste and selective feeding.
- Can be fed as a complete diet to high producing animals.
- Contains enough protein, energy and minerals to meet the requirements requirements for small stock nutrition.
- Formulated with anionic salts to curb instances of urinary calculi and therefore safe to feed to male animals for prolonged periods.
- Can be fed as a supplement to small stock on veld.

FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS

Animals need to be adapted onto Pecus Sheep & Goat 15 for 7 – 14 days when first introduced. The adoption period will depend on the required production system.

Creep Feed:

Pecus Sheep & Goat 15 is highly palatable and the lucerne and protein quality allows it to be used as a creep feed for lambs and kids.

Feedlot Fattening:

Pecus Sheep & Goat 15 can be fed to weaned lambs/kids as starter when entering the feed lot.

Growing out on green pastures:

Pecus Sheep & Goat 15 can be fed to growing rams and lambs kids as a production supplement on green pastures. Feed up to 3% of body weight depending on the pasture quality and quantity.

Production supplement:

Feed Pecus Sheep & Goat 15 to ewes with lambs/kids to ensure maintenance of body condition and milk production. Supplement 300 – 400 g/day to ewes with single lambs and 400 – 600 g/day to ewes with twins.

Flush Feed:

Use Pecus Sheep & Goat 15 strategically as a flush feed for ewes with a poor body condition. Start feeding 4 – 6 weeks before mating at 300 – 500 g/day to ensure ewes are actively gaining weight by the time they are mated. **Ensure that a Pecus Trace Mineral block is always available to animals receiving Pecus Sheep & Goat 15.**
