FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS

During times where pasture and roughage are scarce, Pecus Drought Pellets can be fed in limited amounts to animals. During severe drought conditions it is better to feed only twice per week but provide enough for 3 – 4 days. This will allow more animals to ingest their allocated pellet volume, ensuring better survival rates.

Sheep & Goats: Feed at a rate of 15 – 18 g/kg body weight. A

goat weighing 40 kg should consume 600 – 720 g of Pecus Drought Pellet per day.

Cattle: Feed at a rate of 9,5 – 11,5 g/kg of body

weight. A cow weighing 400 kg should consume 3,8 – 4,6 kg of Pecus Drought Pellets

per day.

Game animals: Pecus Drought Pellet are safe to feed to game.
